WHAT IS I-BEST?

I-BEST refers to *Integrated Basic Education Skills Training*. In the I-BEST program, you will have the benefit of two instructors. One of them is a specialist in their technical field. The other is a specialist in basic skills such as English, reading, and math. You will work in the program classes with both instructors and in support classes with the basic skills teacher.
